Location: The match will be shot at the Midland County Sportsman's Club, 8825 Sturgeon Road, Midland, Michigan.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules will govern. This is a NRA sanctioned league.

Entries: Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using a registration card. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Mid-Range High Power Rifle classification and NRA member number. You may complete the card and pay upon arriving at the range. Due range capacity constraints we will limit competitors to eighteen (18).

Entries Close: The morning of each match. **Post Entries:** There are no post entry fees.

Squadding: This match will be squadded. Squadding will begin at 8:00 AM. We plan on closing Squadding at 8:30 AM, so that the sponsors have time to shoot. Either two or three relays will be used. You will be required to perform pit service.

Zero Verification: You must verify your zero at 100 yards for each rifle sight combination that you will be using. Verification targets will be available on the range.

FEES: Registration: \$7.00 (paid only once). Price \$20.00 per day (not including registration fee); Note: Junior Shooters may compete for \$15.00 per day (plus \$7.00 one time registration), but will receive no awards, except a High Junior Trophy will be awarded to the highest Junior competitor, providing that there are at least five (5) Junior shooters entered.

Time of Firing: The match will commence at 9:00 AM.

Classification: The NRA High Power Mid-Range Classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class for their first day. Assigned, or Temporary Classifications maybe used.

Rifle Allowed: Any Rifle with sights as specified by the program. F-Type defined as any rifle rule 3.2 fired from a rest will be allowed in a separate category. No muzzle breaks allowed.

Course of Fire each date specified:

STAGE 1 unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 600 yards, MR Target, Any Sights.

STAGE 2 unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 600 yards, MR Target, Any Sights.

MATCH 1 An aggregate of Stages 1, and 2.

Categories and Classes: There will be no categories or classes. However, we will separate F-Class and Service Rifle to establish bragging rights. **Award Disposition:** No awards will be provided, however, all shooters will receive a participation memento.

Notes to Competitors:

- 1) Competitors maybe required to serve as line officer during the competition.
- 2) *COACHING IS PERMITTED* for all matches.
- 3) Issues will be decided by royal decree.

WEATER: Due to the unpredictability of weather in Michigan during the "spring" months at 6:00 AM the Friday prior to each match date we will review the forecast for 9:00 AM the day of the match in Midland, Michigan, and the match will be on if: the temperature is forecasted to be greater than 30 degrees F, and it is expected to be dry (SNOW is actually okay). Directions to: the Midland County Sportsman's Club, 8825 Sturgeon Road, Midland, Michigan

From the East (from I-75). Take US-10 to the Eastman Rd. exit. The exit faces Airport Rd. So just cross Eastman and go right onto Airport Rd. Sturgeon is 1 mile to the West. Turn North (right), Club is on left, about 1 1/2 miles.

From the West (from US-27) take US-10 to the Eastman Exit. That exits onto Wackerly Rd. Turn right (West) onto Wackerly off the exit. Sturgeon is about 1/2 mile West. Turn North onto Sturgeon and club is about 1 1/2 miles on the left.
